Any organisation or activities relating to the welfare of all animals, domestic and wild.



ARCHITECTURE (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services relating to the design, construction and management of hard landscape works in urban, semi-urban and rural areas, including suppliers, designers and implementation/maintenance contractors and consultants.



BIOTECHNOLOGY (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services involving the use of living organisms to solve an engineering problem or perform an industrial task or the use of biological substances or techniques to engineer or manufacture a product or substance.



BOTANICAL

Activities pertaining to, made from, or containing plants.



CLEANER PRODUCTION – TECHNOLOGIES & PRODUCTS (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services that facilitate cleaner, more resource efficient technologies, processes or products.



COMMERCE, TRADE & INDUSTRY

Activities including Communications & Information Technology, Banking & Finance, Manufacturing, Mining, Retailing, Transport.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & MANAGEMENT

Activities relating to all aspects of development & management embracing the input from and upliftment of communities.



CONSERVATION

Activities relating to the conservation of Fauna, Flora, Culture, Architecture, Marine Environment, Wilderness and Protected Areas.



CONSULTANCY SERVICES (EGS)

Services to provide assessment and advice relating to environmental issues – Including environmental audits, environmental management systems & training, life cycle assessment, environmental impact assessment, advice on biodiversity, regulations & corporate responsibility.

Environmental Goods & Services relating to the design, construction and management of hard landscape works in urban, semi-urban and rural areas, including suppliers, designers and implementation/maintenance contractors and consultants.



ENVIRONMENTAL LAW & RISK MANAGEMENT (EGS)

Services relating to environmental Law & Legislation, Risk & Liability.



ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT & PLANNING (EGS)

Services relating to Environmental Impact Assessment, Auditing & Due Diligence, Environmental Health, and Land Use Planning.



ENVIRONMENTAL MEDIA

Activities and services relating to communications, broadcasting, electronic media, information media, press, radio, television or public relations pertaining to the environment.



ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY PRODUCTS & SERVICES

Products & Services specifically designed to have minimal negative impact on the Environment and Society including Food & Beverages, Cleaning Products, Clothing & Accessories, Health & Beauty, Baby & Child Care, Appliances, Transport, Holiday & Leisure, Petcare, Garden & Home, Décor & Furniture, Energy, Water Saving, Recycling Goods & Services, Office Supplies & Equipment.



FARMING

Products & Services relating to Agriculture, Forestry, Fisheries.



GOVERNANCE

Activities relating to Legislation, and National & Local Government.

HEALTHCARE

Goods, Services & Activities relating to Human Health particularly pertaining to environmental factors.



LANDSCAPING & URBAN GREENING (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services relating to the design, construction & management of soft landscape works in urban, semi-urban and rural areas, also landscape assessment/planning. Encompasses suppliers, designers & implementation/maintenance contractors & consultants.



MARINE

Activities, processes, systems, goods & services (EGS) related to the marine environment, including Fisheries, Pollution Control, Research & Development.



MONITORING, INSTRUMENTATION & ANALYSIS (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services for measuring and monitoring environmental parameters, including water, air and soil quality, meteorological conditions and flow rates, including on site and laboratory analysis.



NOISE & VIBRATION CONTROL (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services relating to the identification and examination of noise and vibration issues in general; specification and analysis, definition and evaluation of solutions.



NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION

Organisations including NGO's, CBO's, TRUST's, SECTION 21 COMPANIES etc.



PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS & INSTITUTIONS

Organisations that are officially recognised within their industry sector as a Professional Association or Institution.



RECYCLING & RECOVERY

Environmental Goods & Services relating to any part of the cycles of reclamation, recovery, refining, reprocessing or conversion of discarded products and materials.



REMEDICATION & CLEANUP (EGS)

Environmental Goods & Services relating to the identification, assessment & remediation/reclamation of land & buildings, including prevention of contaminant dispersal. Examples include adsorbents & injection equipment, monitoring systems & treatment processes, sampling/analysis, site investigation/ engineering & re-vegetation techniques.



RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT (EGS)

Activities relating to basic or applied research for the purpose of creating new, or for improving existing materials, devices, products or processes.



SPECIALIST SERVICES

Specific services which are not represented by any of the other listed activities.

STANDARDS, CERTIFICATION & ACCREDITATION (EGS)

Services relating to the official sanctioning of various environmental standards, certification or accreditation or involved in development thereof.



SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Activities, Goods or Services designed to support the process of 'Development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.' and which demonstrate a care and respect for People and Planet.



WASTE MANAGEMENT

Environmental Goods & Services relating to the minimisation, collection, treatment, segregation, and disposal of waste including paper, organics, metals, glass, plastics, demolition and construction wastes, electrical and white goods.



WATER

Environmental Goods & Services including Research or Conservation relating to Wastewater, Water Supply, Water Quality, Water Management.



WILDLIFE

Activities relating to Wildlife Conservation, Research and Development, including Avian Research & Development, Entomology, Wildlife Products & Services, and Wildlife Management.
